

# Project Rescue

Ten ways YOU can become the difference:

1. Research sex trafficking and/or ministries providing restorative care for women and children victimized by this epidemic for your next school project.
2. Host a fundraiser to create awareness and raise money for programs providing healing to survivors of sexual slavery (i.e., car wash, bake sale, rummage sale, walk-a-thon, bike-a-thon, marathon, read-a-thon...you get the idea ☺)
3. Set aside one lunch hour each week to pray and fast for victims of sex trafficking.
4. Host a small group to learn more about the issue and discuss a way that your church/school/community can get involved. We can provide you with information and resources to accomplish this. Email us for more info!
5. Volunteer a few days a week, a summer, or a year at a local or international organization that is committed to the eradication of sexual slavery and providing restorative aftercare to survivors.
6. Call your local and state government representatives to voice your concern about the issue and ask that they make fighting against sex trafficking a top priority issue.
7. Host a prayer night at your church to pray for victims of sex trafficking
8. Take three minutes a day to pray for the three tiered mission of Project Rescue:
  - a. **Rescue:** Our efforts to remove women and girls who have been forced into prostitution begin with providing long-term shelter in a safe place in which trust and healing can develop.
  - b. **Restore:** Addressing the physical, emotional, mental, and educational needs of (our) rescued women and girls
  - c. **Prevent:** strengthening a community's lack of tolerance for sex trafficking and sexual slavery
